History

Only 11 years after the founding of the Güntensperger cheese dairy in 1868, football-mad St.Gallen citizens joined forces to form FC St.Gallen on 18 April 1879. This makes FCSG the oldest football club in Switzerland. The enthusiasm and passion that the green and white aspens spread throughout eastern Switzerland is matched in no small measure by FC St.Gallen 1879 Cheese. As a tribute to the favourite club of the brothers Reto and Marcel Güntensperger and cousin Roman Egli, it embodies the tradition, loyalty and emotionality of a great regional success story that creates storms of enthusiasm on and off the pitch.
